SHROVE TUESDAY

Shrove Tuesday or "**Pancake Day**" is a day in February or March which is celebrated in English speaking countries by eating lots of pancakes. People celebrate Shrove Tuesday in different ways. In some countries, people wear masks. The most famous carnivals are in Venice and Rio de Janeiro.

Traditionally, people eat pancakes on Shrove Tuesday because they want to use rich foods like eggs, milk, and sugar. After Shrove Tuesday, some religious people stop eating some foods for 40 days – that is until Easter, the next festival.

In Slovenia, children eat doughnuts, put on costumes, go door to door and enjoy carnivals. In Spain, they also have festivals, when they eat omelettes with sausages and they wear masks. In Estonia, children eat pea soup and sweet bread. They also put on warm clothes, go up the hill and sledge or ski down the hill.

In the United Kingdom, Ireland, Australia and Canada, they eat lots of pancakes on Shrove Tuesday. In some parts of Canada, people often add small objects in them. They say that the person who gets a coin, for example, will be rich.

UNUSUAL COMPETITIONS

WELLY WANGING

Welly wanging comes from Britain. It is a throwing competition where competitors throw a Wellington boot called a welly. The boot must be green and big enough. Competitors have to be 14 years old. They can use a left or right boot. Before they throw it, they can wait for the right wind, but only for a minute. The sport is popular in New Zealand and European countries like Finland, Germany and Poland.

CHEESE ROLLING

Once a year, usually in May, there is a Cheese Rolling event in Gloucester, England. The competition takes place after the winter is over. A large cheese wheel is rolled down a hill. The first person to reach the bottom of the hill wins the cheese. It looks safe and easy, but there are always some people who get hurt running down the hill. Many must go to hospital because they break their bones.

YUKIGASSEN BATTLE

It must be cold enough to do this sport. Yukigassen is a snowball fight competition. The name comes from the Japanese words *yuki* for snow and *kassen* for battle. There are two teams of seven players in this game. Before the match starts, each team makes 90 snowballs. The winner is the team that takes the other team's flag or puts all the opposite team members out of the game by hitting them with snowballs. Players wear special helmets to protect their heads and faces.

BED RACING

One of the most unusual competitions in the world is Bed Racing. The competitors race in teams of five, plus one on the bed. Team members wear matching t-shirts and trainers. Each team must build their own bed and decorate it. The bed has four wheels. The team pushes it down a road and up and down a hill. Before they reach the finish line, the team must also swim across a river.

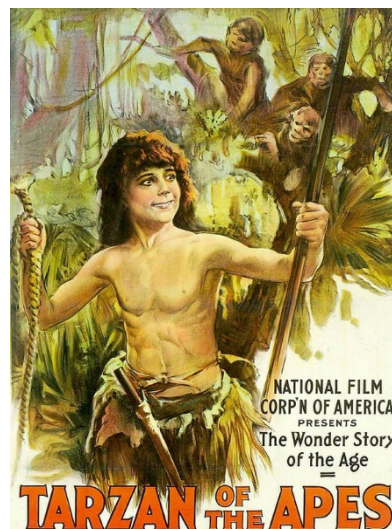

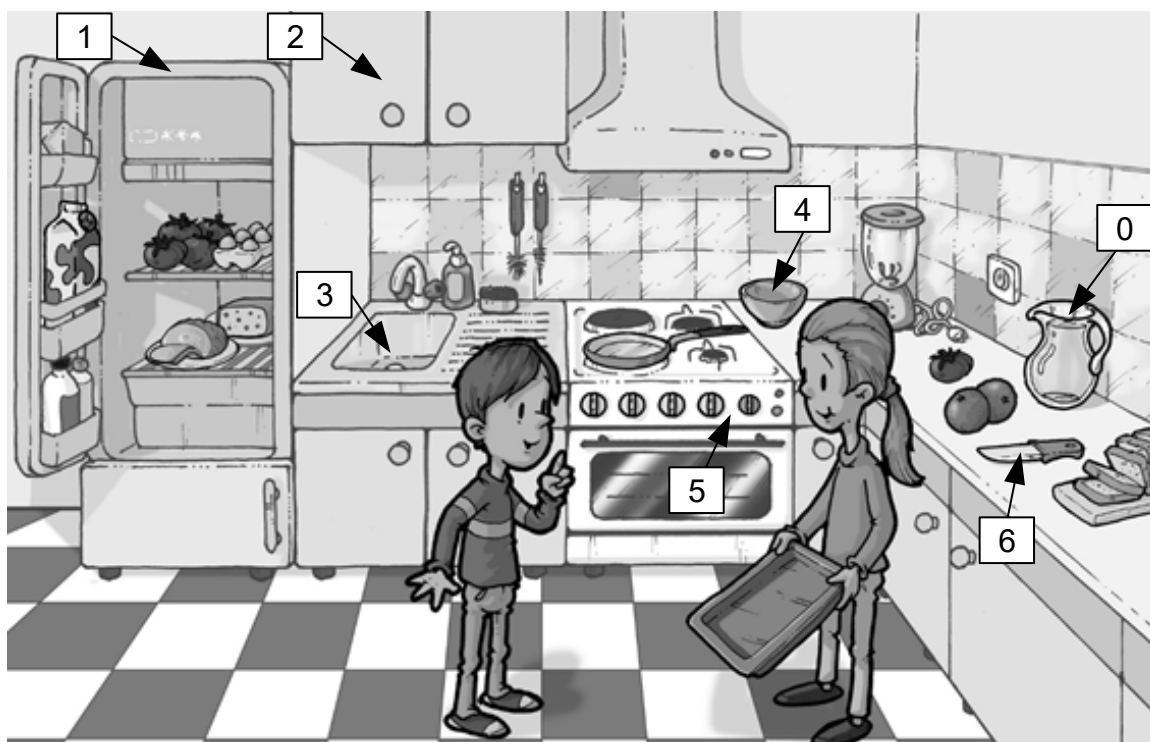
