How broken is James Bond's body?

Would 007 pass a physical examination?

After 25 movies in 59 years, it's time for James Bond to make an 0 with a doctor. After all, surely a 1 of dodging bullets, fighting villains, jumping off buildings and regularly drinking more cocktails than a Blackpool hen night cannot be good for you? We asked Carl Heneghan – a GP and professor of evidence-based medicine at the University of Oxford – to sit Bond down for his 2 .

The name's injury, head injury

James Bond has been knocked unconscious from hits to the head 14 times 3 his career. "These are serious head traumas that will 4 brain function," says Heneghan. "In the long term we're talking chronic traumatic encephalopathy, a neurodegenerative disease that plagues contact sports like American football." Symptoms could include early onset dementia, anxiety, depression and impaired judgment. "You could say, in terms of the films, some of those are already there. Especially the impulse control problems."

Shaken, also slurred

In a study published in 2018 by *The Medical Journal of Australia*, it was calculated that over the course of 24 movies Bond was observed drinking 109 times, 5 4.5 drinks per movie. "Long-term alcohol consumption will lead to a process called fatty liver disease, and eventually cirrhosis," says Heneghan.

STI another day

Over the course of 25 films, James Bond has slept with around 57 women. This isn't a problem within itself, of course. But when was the last time you saw Bond pause a romantic scene to 6 , ahem, protection? "His risks are going through the roof in terms of sexually transmitted diseases like gonorrhoea or chlamydia," says Heneghan. "In the long term, Bond may have problems with sterility and inflammatory disease, and if left 7 that inflammation could give him a heightened risk of cancer."

Bullets galore

During his time in the field, Bond has dodged at least 4,662 bullets. However, he was hit in *Skyfall*, where he is shot first in the shoulder, then in the chest and sent plummeting to a river far below. "If a bullet misses all the major organs and arteries, you can 8 it," says Heneghan. But I would say it would take at least a year to get back to normal afterwards."

Heartbreaker

One of *Casino Royale*'s most punishing scenes sees Bond poisoned by digitalis, which can give you a cardiac arrest. But not to worry: thanks to a prompt defibrillation, Her Majesty's finest spy is resurrected – and returns to a high-stakes poker game minutes later. "It's implausible but not impossible that would resuscitate him and he would 9 ," says Heneghan. "But the damage to his heart would have been significant. It would take a long time to strengthen his heart muscle, which does not recover like other muscles in the body."

Olive Morris

FEMINIST TRAILBLAZER

1952–79

By the late sixties, Black communities in Britain were under siege, __0__ of popular and institutional racism. Discrimination in housing, employment and policing was __10__ on their lives.

Racism was becoming more forceful and permissible. Enoch Powell's 'Rivers of Blood' speech in 1968, an incendiary attack on Commonwealth migration, influenced white supremacist groups such as the National Front to incite violence against these communities. Black children were being classed as "educationally subnormal", and unemployment was rife among African-Caribbean youth.

Consequently, Black organisations __11__ these injustices began to emerge, advocating self-defence and self-reliance.

It was within this period that Olive Morris came of age politically. Aged 17, while __12__ of Desmond's Hip City, one of the first Black-owned record shops in Brixton, she was caught up in an incident of police brutality.

Clement Gomwalk, a Nigerian diplomat, was arrested and beaten by two policemen after they pulled him over in his Mercedes and accused him of stealing it. In the words of the journalist Aymo Martin Tajo, Morris "broke through the crowd to the scuffle... and tried physically to stop the police beating Gomwalk". The police, believing her to be a man (she was wearing men's clothing and had short hair) turned on her, viciously kicking her and raining down blows until she fell to the ground. She was charged with __13__ and engaging in threatening behaviour, and received a suspended sentence.

Morris began to contest injustice, joining the British Black Panther Party Youth League and __14__ physically and intellectually against police violence and racism. She understood the need to address the dual oppressions of being Black and female, __15__ and the Organisation of Women of Asian and African Descent. Both of these organisations provided advice and guidance for women about issues that affected their lives, such as housing, education, employment and welfare. They also brought together Black and Asian women from different backgrounds and political perspectives across Britain, __16__ their own study and self-help groups.

When, in 1975, Morris enrolled at Manchester University to study social sciences, she juggled the pressures of being a student with her personal call to activism. She got involved with community groups in Moss Side and was an active member of the Manchester Black Women's Co-operative, before __17__ work back in Brixton.

Morris died of cancer in July 1979, aged just 27. She left behind an extraordinary legacy of community activism, committed to the struggle against race, sex and class oppression.
