THE LITTLE PEOPLE FROM HAWAII

Everyone knows about elves, witches, and ghosts. But do you know anything about Menehunes, the little people of Hawaii? According to legend, Menehunes live in the mountains and hidden valleys of the Hawaiian Islands. They make their homes in huts, caves, or hollow logs. People who claim to have seen the Menehunes say they're two to three feet tall with strong, muscular bodies and big dark eyes that peer out from under the shaggy eyebrows. Their low, gruff voices sound like the growl of a dog.



The Menehunes' special skill is stonework. Stories tell of the many buildings, roads, bridges, waterways, and fishponds they have built throughout the Hawaiian Islands. Oddly enough, the Menehunes work only at night when they can't be seen, and they use only stone hammers. And if they don't finish something by morning, it is left undone.

People who claim to have heard the Menehunes at play say they are merry and talkative. They make their own musical instruments like trumpets and drums using leaves and logs. The Menehunes are fond of games, too. One of their favourites is pushing stones over a cliff, then diving into the cool water to touch them on the ocean floor. Another is rolling themselves down soft, grassy hills. Often Menehunes take part in foot-racing and spear-throwing competitions.

Some people say that at one time there were large numbers of Menehunes on one of the islands. But legend tells us that the Menehune king was very concerned because his men were marrying Hawaiian women, and he ordered all the Menehunes to leave this island. They slipped away on a beautiful, floating island that disappeared into the Pacific mist. A few who could not bear to leave their Hawaiian wives and children hid until the others were out of sight. These Menehunes remained behind on the island. There are some Hawaiians today who claim to be their descendants.

Do Menehunes really exist? Some people say yes, that they are the true natives of the island, the Aborigines. Others know them only as mythical beings invented by the storytellers. Still others claim they are supernatural beings such as gods or forest spirits.

RAPSTYLE

Visit the shopping mall of small towns USA and you'll see rap's impact on teen style. The boys with oversized hoodies and oversized pants that are pulled down low, and the girls wearing tight, short tops and low jeans. How come?

According to MTV viewer reports, a large number of teens watch music videos more than two hours a day. There on screen are cool and rebellious rappers, looking and sounding unique. Teens want a slice of that image, particularly if they come from Dullsville, USA which is only an invented name for a place that is boring. Wearing the same clothes as rappers who often sing violent or offensive lyrics, can make the person in the clothes feel very cool and rebellious too. And rap fashion is big business; last year over \$ 2 billion worth of rap style clothing was sold.

Rap and hip-hop were born in the ghettos of New York City over 30 years ago. Not too many years later, hip-hop performers wore expensive designer labels such as Polo, Ralph Lauren or Tommy Hilfiger and sang about Prada and Gucci. The clothes were often worn differently, for example wearing a baseball cap backwards or leaving shoelaces untied. Rappers boasted with enormous gold necklaces and jewel-covered watches or by driving costly cars. Sometimes the sparkle on the cars and jewelry was very extravagant so it became known as a slang term Bling Bling.

Rap wouldn't be rap without its bad boy image. It's well known that Snoop Dogg and 50 Cent used to sell drugs and both have faced murder charges. So does rap glamorize crime? Eminem, who admits he likes to provoke people with his music, believes it's senseless to blame rap for teen violence. He sings:

"They say music can alter moods and talk to you.
Well can it load a gun and pull its trigger too?
Well if it can, the next time you assault a dude,
just tell the judge it was my fault and I'll get sued."

Critics also accuse rap music of degrading women. Fans say this is because many rap singers come from families of broken marriages. The question is, do their songs affect teen attitudes toward women? 18-year-old Stephanie Alves from Boston says yes. At school, she heard girls described with bad words all the time and the guys were all into guns and money. Stephanie felt insulted. Instead of just getting angry, she did something about it. She wrote to the mayor of Boston suggesting a new radio station that played rap – without sexist lyrics. He loved the idea, and he established the station. No artists are banned, but some of their songs are.

THE FRENCH REVOLUTION

In 1789, the population of France was divided into three (0) g **r** o u p s: the priests, the aristocracy and the common people. Louis XVI was king from 1774. When he was 16, he married Marie Antoinette, who was a (2) d _____ of the Austrian Emperor. In 1789, France was in crisis. Peasants refused to pay high taxes. People in towns went on strike. Many were very poor and so unhappy because the king and his family were (3) r _____. They lived in great luxury. That is why the people wanted changes. They also wanted more freedom and the same rights for all.

Civil war broke out (4) b _____ the royalists on one hand and the republicans on the other. The royalists believed in the monarchy and the republicans believed in the new form of government. Thousands of nobles, including the queen Antoinette, were guillotined. From September 1793 to July 1794 the violence got even worse. This period of time was called "the Reign of Terror".

In 1795, a young French general called Napoleon Bonaparte managed to stop war and bring back order and (6) p _____ in France. On 9th November 1799 Napoleon took over the government.
