MAYAS

Most Mayas live in city states. Each state has a city and a group of villages surrounding it. The city states are special because there are pyramids and palaces. I like spending time in the Main Square. This is the place where people organize festivals. Sometimes the musicians from other city states come and I really enjoy myself.

THE LONDON BUS

What is special about the famous, red, double-decker London buses?



- 6.5 million people go on London buses every day. Five thousand buses do five million journeys daily.
- London buses are red because red is a strong colour that is easy to see.
- The traditional red London bus is called 'Routemaster' and it runs every 10 minutes. These double-decker buses have no door at the back. People just jump on and off the bus anywhere. A bus conductor works on a bus. He is a person who sells tickets. But some people say such buses are dangerous. And it is the end of the Routemaster bus in 2005.
- After 2005 a new type of bus drives in London – the bendy bus. It is very long and can carry 140 passengers – a normal London bus carries 70. You must buy a ticket before you get on. Londoners don't like them and they say that bendy buses are dangerous to the bikers and pedestrians because they are so long. And it is the end of the bendy bus in 2011.
- London still has double-decker buses today but they are modern. The bus looks different from the old double-decker bus. Now it has a new design, a low floor. It has a door at the back, but the driver can close it. There are 600 of these buses in London. There is no conductor. In 2003, people start paying with a plastic, electronic payment card.
- In 2014, Routemaster is sixty years old. For that celebration, they make a special silver bus in London and a special silver ticket, too! You can still take a ride on this bus today.
- Do you know that Londoners sometimes see a number 7 London bus without a driver at night? It's like a ghost bus but it is different from the Knight Bus from the Harry Potter book. The Knight Bus is blue, very very fast and can jump and it hasn't got a number.
