

### DEAR JULIET...

Every year, thousands of letters arrive in Verona, Italy, simply addressed to 'Romeo and Juliet' or just 'Juliet'. Nobody seems to mind that the unfortunate lovers of William Shakespeare's famous play do not really exist, and if they once did, are long dead now. All of them pour out their feelings, asking Juliet for advice about affairs of the heart. The letters come from all over the world. But the amazing thing is that they all get replies.

The Juliet Club answers over 5,000 letters a year, from a tiny office in the middle of Verona. Thousands of people all around the world tell Juliet their story. Giulio Tamassia, President of the Club, passed away in 2018, but his daughter, Giovanna, continues his work with a team of helpers and translators to answer letters from lovers and would-be lovers from all over the world. The majority of the letters are written by the Americans and the French followed by the Turks, the Chinese, and the Russians but only a few by the Germans and the British.

The Club began in 1937 when a lovesick Englishman addressed the first recorded letter to 'Juliet, Verona'. His letter received a reply from a kind-hearted man called Signor Solimani, who was the guardian of Juliet's tomb. He wrote as if he was Juliet's secretary, and this began a tradition which heartbroken, lovesick, abandoned, confused and even happy lovers everywhere have continued ever since. Over the years, responsibility for the Club was taken up by various generous-spirited romantics until Signor Tamassia took on the job in 1989. The Club is partly funded by the local council.

What kind of letters do they get? Letters from the Turks are often straightforward. They complain that they can't get a bus to the next village to see their boyfriend or girlfriend – that sort of thing. The French always seem to have the most complex problems. Sometimes the problems seem to have no solutions. What could anyone suggest to the young Lebanese woman who wrote: "I cannot seem to find my Romeo. The problem is that, with the wars and economic problems, all the ambitious men have left for America or Europe. I am not the only Juliet who is left waiting – there are twelve women for every man in Lebanon."

Then there was the young girl from Rome who saw her boyfriend from Milan only at the weekends; and the twenty-two-year old French girl who wondered whether it was normal to find her boyfriend incredibly boring and wanted to know what true love was like.

In our technological era, dominated by instant messages that have no time, nor space (text messages, emails, WhatsApp, etc.), hand-written letters are still the preferred way to express feelings. There are still thousands of people in all countries that take a pen and a sheet of paper in order to write to Juliet. Perhaps Juliet really would know all the answers. It seems the world is no easier for lovers than it was when she left it.

## GLACIERS



### Perito Moreno Glacier, Argentina

This glacier, not far from the regional capital of Patagonian glaciers El Calafate, is one of the most visited attractions in Argentina. The place itself has become a very popular destination because tourists from all over the world come here only to see the glacier. The glacier is unusual since it is advancing and represents the world's third largest fresh water reserve. There are three viewing points located on land, which offer views from different sides and angles. There are also boat rides along the glacial lake to take a closer look at the glacier and helicopter rides that give a truly unique and unforgettable experience.

### Furtwangler Glacier, Tanzania

Africa is not usually a place associated with any large glaciers, but at the top of Mount Kilimanjaro, sits a small remnant of an ice cap. And indeed it is one of the most amazing glaciers in the world that fascinates backpackers, less experienced trekkers, as well as competent climbers all year around. This glacier has decreased rapidly over the past century and today, only 18 percent of it remains intact. The size does increase slightly during the brief snowfall season but the degradation of this glacier continues even today.

Although 6 metres thick, it is estimated that it will probably completely melt in the next few decades or so.



### Pasterze Glacier, Austria

This glacier may not be one of the largest in the world because it is just over 8 kilometres long, but it is definitely one of the most amazing because of its location and beautiful ice formations. Pasterze is regularly visited by a large number of people and is also one of the most popular selfie background motives seen on social media. It is situated at the base of the tallest mountain in Austria, the Grossglockner and is also the largest glacier in the Eastern Alps.

Currently, the thickness of this rapidly receding glacier is about 122 metres. The length is decreasing by 10 metres per year and the thickness is shrinking annually, too. It may retreat at a much faster pace and melt away eventually.





## Biafo Glacier, Pakistan



This glacier is located in the Karakoram mountain range in Pakistan and is 36 kilometres long. It is located at a height of over 5000 meters. This glacier however is not a popular tourist destination due to the extremely difficult climb. There's no developed transport connecting the trek route to the mountain range which is far away from larger cities. Like most other glaciers, this one too, is threatened by global warming and is melting rapidly. This glacial system supplies many of Pakistan's rivers that emerge from the Karakoram Range.
